Report on non-personal data

The Committee of Experts on non-personal data governance framework constituted by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India, under the Chairmanship of Kris Gopalakrishnan (Co-Founder, Infosys) released its report on 12 July 2020.

The report covers key aspects such as data and socio-economic impact, definition of non-personal data, ownership of data, undertaking a data business, data sharing, non-personal data regulatory authority. This report will impact on businesses in data industry and is now open for feedback from public.



Data breach at Dunzo

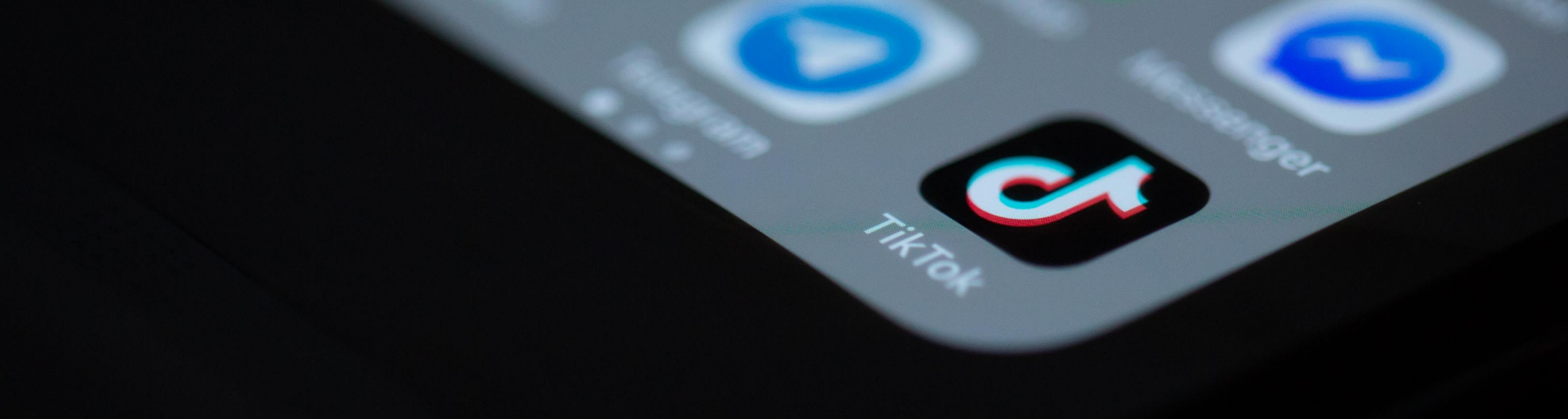

Google fined EUR 600,000 by Belgian DPA

The Belgian Data Protection Authority (gegevensbeschermingsautoriteit) issued its highest ever fine of EUR 600,000 on Google Belgium for violation of right to be forgotten under GDPR.

Google had refused applicants request of dereference from outdated articles considered to be seriously damaging to its reputation.



COVID-19 patient's info denied

The McHenry County Health Department won an appeal with the Second District Appellate Court of Illinois reversing the previous order wherein access was granted to names and addresses of those who test positive for COVID-19. Now it will no longer have to release names of COVID-19 patients.
