## **Enforcement Updates**



### OCR settles with three for HIPPA violation

In the month of September 2020, the Office for Civil Rights (OCR) at the U.S. Department of Health and Human Service settled violations under Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) Privacy and Security Rules with three organization:

- 1. Athens Orthopedic Clinic PA for HIPPA non-compliance USD 1.5 million
- 2. CHSPSC LLC for data breach of 6 million individuals USD 2.3 million
- 3. Premera Blue Cross for data breach 10.4 million individuals USD 6.85 million



### SIC, Columbia fines under PDPL

Superintendencia de Industria y Comercio (SIC), Columbian national authority for the protection of personal data, sanctioned fines for violation under Personal Data Protection Law (PDPL):

- 1. Banco Popular with a fine of COL 269,046,492 for default in data deletion
- Movistar Colombia with a fine of COL 263,349,372 for marketing without consent



### Dunkin' settles with New York AG

New York Attorney General recently announced a settlement with Dunkin' for data breach pertaining to 2015. Nearly 20000 Dunkin' customer's accounts were targeted resulting loss of customer's data, funds and also failed in investigate the attack. Dunkin' has now agreed to ensure and maintain data protection mechanism, refund the customers and also pay an additional USD 650,000 in penalties.
