# Enforcement updates



## OCC fines Multinational Banks

The Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC), United States Department of the Treasury imposed civil money penalties against Multinational Banks

1. Morgan Stanley assessed with penalty of USD 60 million for failures to address risks with data disposal practices.
2. CitiBank assessed with penalty of USD 400 million for deficiencies in enterprise-wide risk management, compliance risk management, data governance, and internal controls. Additionally, a cease-desist order has also been issued.



## 28 US states settles with CHS for data breach

A multi-state settlement agreement to make an payment of \$5 million to the 28 participating US states has been entered into with acute care hospitals operator CHS/Community Health Systems resolving 2014 data breach which exposed names, birthdates, Social Security numbers, phone numbers, and addresses of about 6.1 million patients.

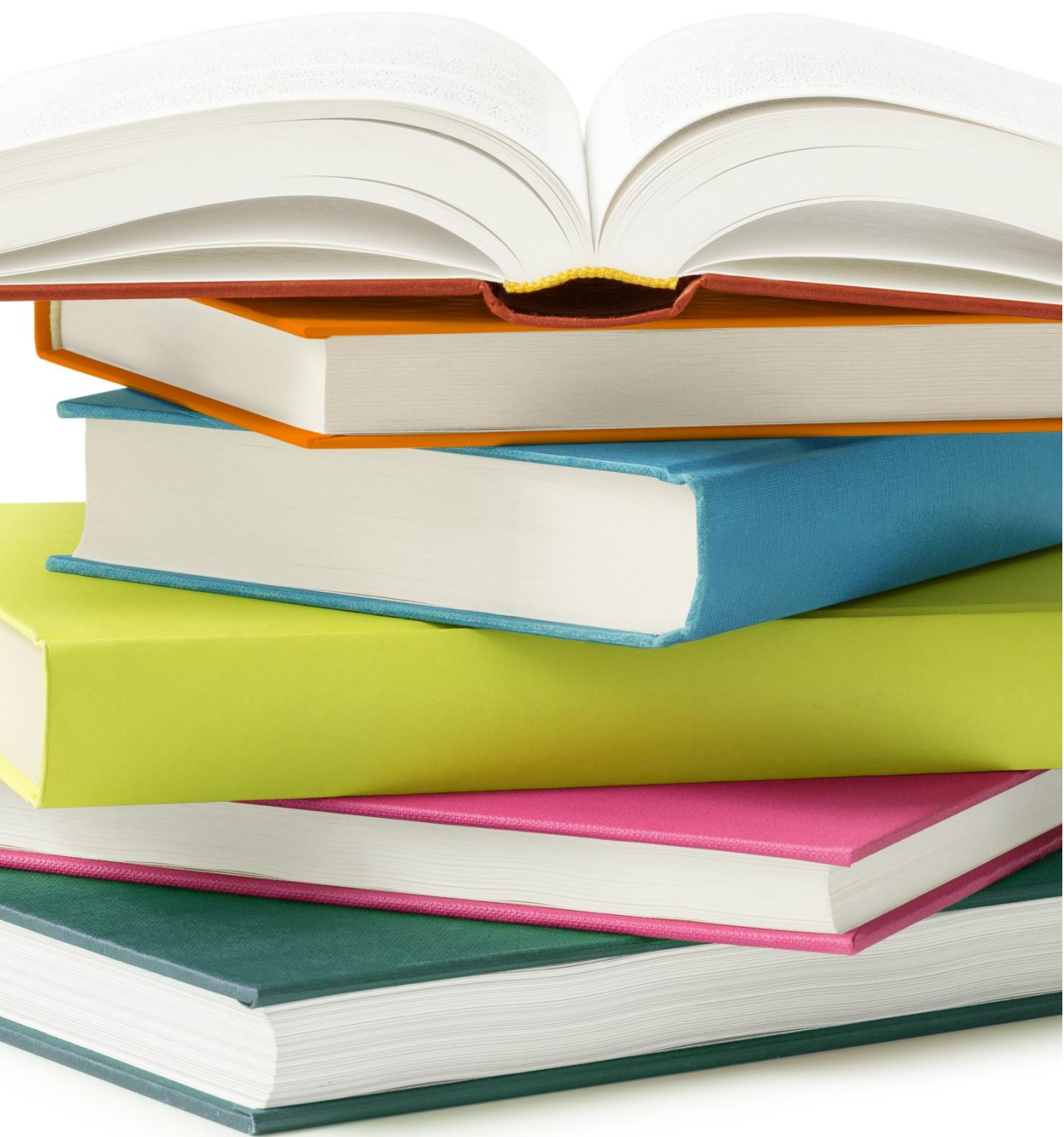
