



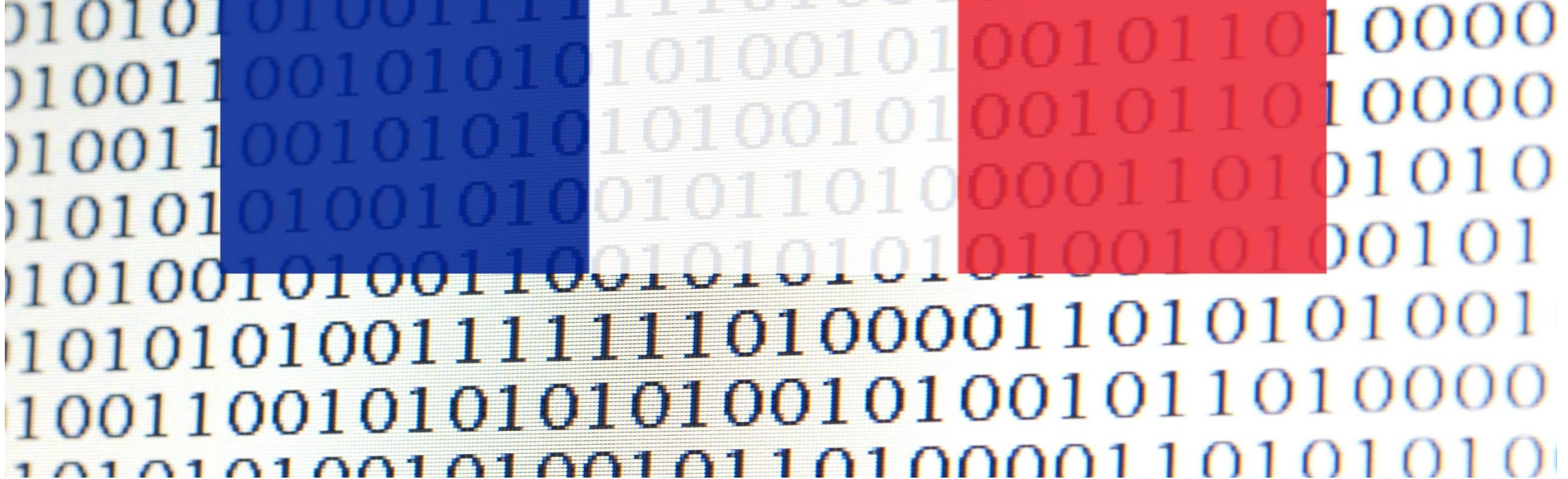

Enforcement updates



French watchdog fined Carrefour entities

CNIL, the French Data protection authority issued fines on Carrefour France (retail) and Carrefour Banque (banking) for violations under the Data Protection Act, the General Data Protection Regulation and the Postal and Electronic Communications Code.

Carrefour France was fined with EUR 2.25 million for unjustified data retention and not acting on data deletion request by the customers. Separately, Carrefour Banque was fined EUR 800,000 for failing to fairly process data of its customers and other failures constituting breach.



The Home Depot settles data breach investigation

The Home Depot, the largest home improvement retailer in US has entered into a settlement agreement with the office of the New York Attorney General pertaining to a multistate data breach investigation against it. As part of the settlement The Home Depot has agreed to pay USD 17.5 million to 46 states and to strengthen its information security program.



Upward Labs Holdings & Glow settles data privacy and protection charges

A lawsuit was filed against Upward Labs Holdings and Glow for failure to protect sensitive medical information and security lapses under California Medical Information Act, Unfair Competition Law and False Advertising Law. Following the charges, Upward Labs Inc. and Glow Inc. entered into settlement with the California Attorney General, agreeing to pay USD 250,000 as civil penalty and comply with other directions issued as part of the settlement order.



Secure Solutions fined by PDPC

Singapore data protection authority (PDPC) imposed a fine of SGD 120,000 on Secure Solutions Group under the Personal Data Protection Act 2012 as it failed to deploy sufficient security measures to protect personal data of blood donors available on their database.
