

Family Service fined in Belgium

Belgian Data Protection Authority fined marketing company, Family Service with EUR 50,000, as it failed to notify and obtain consent of users before processing and sharing personal data, including sensitive personal data with third parties including data brokers. It was also revealed by the authority that the company, sold and rented users data to data brokers.

Claims in class action against Care First revived

A US Federal Judge allowed the motion for reconsideration, allowing policy holders of Health Insurance Company Care First to revive their claims against the company following a 2014 data breach incident. Initially the claims were dismissed due to inadequately pleaded damages by the complainant. However, the federal judge has allowed the claimants to pursue their claims under consumer protection—laws of Virginia and Maryland.




Czech watchdog to scrutinize Covid-19 vaccine registration system

The Office for Personal Data Protection (UOOU) will investigate a company engaged in providing online system of registration for COVID-19 vaccination. The Authority has received complaints containing serious suspicion of breach of personal data protection legislation during data processing by the company. The investigation will focus on assessing the legitimacy of the transfer of personal data to the US via use of cookies, verification of data security measures adopted for such transfers, and asserting whether obligation for processing personal data within the system were met.



One more class action suit against Facebook

A class action suit has been filled against Facebook claiming damages in a High Court of Justice, for processing user data of over one million users from New England and Wales. The suit alleges that Facebook failed to ensure control of users' personal data and allowed third party app called "This Is Your Digital Life" to process personal data of UK users, unfairly between 2013 and 2015.
