GST AAR: CSR expenses are business related and qualify for input tax credit

CSR expenditure is incurred by a company in order to comply with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013. Thus, such expenses are incurred in the course of business and are eligible for ITC under GST regulations, according to a GST ruling given by the Authority of Advance Ruling, Uttar Pradesh
