French data watchdog published educational tools on data protection for professionals in the amateur sport sector.



The Court of Justice of the European Union ruled that the publication of personal data that indirectly discloses the sexual orientation of a person constitutes processing of special categories of personal data.



European Data Protection Supervisor issued its opinion on the recommendation for provisions regarding crossborder data flows between EU and Japan.



Latvia's Data State Inspectorate published a guidance on the role of a data protection officer.





The Electronic Privacy Information Center urged the Colorado Attorney General to draft strong rules implementing the Colorado Privacy Act.



California passed the Assembly Bill for the California Age-Appropriate Design Code Act to ensure higher level of privacy protection for children.



The Federal Trade Commission is requesting public comments for its rulemaking on commercial surveillance and data security. Comments may be submitted until 8 September 2022.



Federal jury convicted a former Twitter employee for unlawfully sharing Twitter users' information.

INDIA AND ASIA PACIFIC




The Reserve Bank of India released recommendations on digital lending that include provisions on consent and data minimization.



Australian Federal Court fined Google LLC for AUD 60 million for making misleading representation to customers about their collection and use of location data on Android phones.



The Central Bank of Malaysia provided reassurance on the safety of the national payment system following a potential data breach.



South Korea's Personal Information Privacy Commission fined Balan Co., Ltd. Of KRW 65,659,000 for violating obligations regarding the leakage of personal information.





Jordan's Ministry of Digital Economy and Entrepreneurship approved the National Charter of Ethics for Artificial Intelligence.



Turkey's data watchdog published a guide on good practices regarding personal data protection for the banking industry.
