EU and UK



Ireland's Data Protection Commission submitted a draft decision in a large scale inquiry into Meta Platforms Ireland Limited to other concerned Supervisory Authorities across the EU.



The Council of the European Union approved the Digital Services Act, following the approval by the European Parliament in July 2022.



UK's Data Watchdog issued a fine of GBP 1.48 million for using personal information of its customers to predict their medical condition and target them with health-related products without their consent.



Danish Data Protection Authority issued guidance on GDPR Compliance in election campaigns.



Ireland's Data Protection Commission released guidance on Subject Access Requests for Data Controllers.



Americas



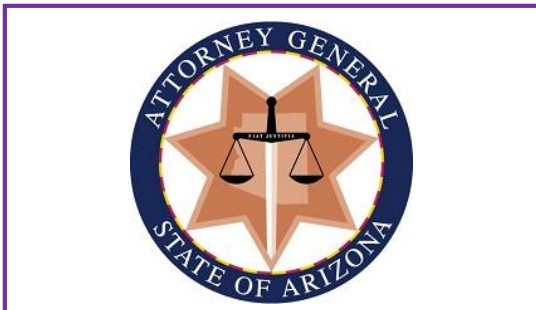
President of the United States of America signed the Executive Order on Enhancing Safeguards for United States Signals Intelligence Activities, to implement EU-US data transfer mechanism.



U.S. Department of Justice announced that the Data Access Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the United Kingdom has entered into force.



U.S. Department of Justice announced in a press release that the former chief security officer of Uber was convicted for covering up data breach involving millions of Uber user records.



Arizona Attorney General announced a settlement with Google LLC for USD 85 million for deceptively obtaining user's personal data under the Arizona Consumer Fraud Act.



India and Asia Pacific



Singapore's Data Protection Watchdog announced that the amendment to increase the maximum financial penalties for breaches under the Personal Data Protection Act 2012 has entered into effect.



The Israeli Government announced the approval of the decision on the independence of the Privacy Protection Authority in the Ministry of Justice.



Philippine's National Privacy Commission issued its statement on the SIM card registration bill.
